



## Redline Goldens Puppy Purchase Agreement

Final buyer contract draft with take-home acknowledgment. Replace the logo placeholder once your final brand asset is ready.

This Puppy Purchase Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between Redline Goldens (the "Breeder") and the undersigned buyer (the "Buyer"). The parties agree as follows:

### 1. PARTIES AND DOG INFORMATION

### 2. PURPOSE OF SALE

The Dog is sold strictly as a companion / pet dog unless the parties later sign a separate written breeding or co-ownership agreement. No oral statement changes this pet-only restriction.

### 3. PURCHASE PRICE AND RESERVATION / FINAL PAYMENT

The total purchase price is listed above. Any deposit is non-refundable unless the Breeder cannot provide the agreed puppy. If the Buyer fails to complete pickup by the agreed date without written approval from the Breeder, the Breeder may treat the sale as canceled, retain any non-refundable deposit, and place the puppy with another home.

### 4. BREEDER DISCLOSURES AT TIME OF TRANSFER

At pickup, the Buyer will receive vaccination and deworming records in the Breeder's possession and any other health information the Breeder has chosen to provide. The Buyer acknowledges that no puppy can be guaranteed to be free of every future illness, injury, allergy, developmental issue, temperament trait, or condition that may arise over the course of the puppy's life.

### 5. BUYER'S INITIAL VETERINARY EXAM

The Buyer must have the Dog examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours after transfer, excluding Sundays and legal holidays when a clinic is unavailable. Failure to complete that exam within the required time waives any claim that the Dog was unhealthy at pickup, except where prohibited by law. Written notice

of any claimed issue must be sent to the Breeder immediately, together with the examining veterinarian's written findings.

The Buyer is responsible for all routine and emergency veterinary costs unless this Agreement expressly provides otherwise.

## 6. HEALTH TERMS AND LIMITED REMEDY

A. General condition at transfer. To the Breeder's knowledge, the Dog is in reasonably good health at the time of transfer.

B. Covered hereditary / congenital condition. If, within one year of the date of transfer, a licensed veterinarian diagnoses the Dog with a severe hereditary or congenital condition that significantly impairs the Dog's quality of life, the Buyer must promptly provide the Breeder with complete veterinary records, diagnostic reports, and a written statement from the diagnosing veterinarian. The Breeder may require a second opinion from a veterinarian of the Breeder's choosing, at the Breeder's expense.

C. Breeder's sole remedy. If a covered hereditary or congenital condition is confirmed, the Breeder's sole obligation, at the Breeder's election, is one of the following: (1) replacement puppy from a future litter when available, or (2) refund of the original purchase price upon return of the Dog if requested by the Breeder. This limited remedy excludes reimbursement for incidental, consequential, special, or emotional-distress damages, and excludes ordinary veterinary bills except where required by applicable law.

D. Non-covered conditions and events. The Breeder is not responsible for conditions, injuries, illnesses, or expenses caused by or associated with events after transfer, including but not limited to swallowed foreign objects, poisoning, choking, household accidents, falls, fractures, bites, rough handling, unsupervised play, exposure to contagious disease after transfer, parasites acquired after transfer, delayed veterinary care, obesity, over-exercise, poor nutrition, breeding, or any other environmental or management factors in the Buyer's home or care.

## 7. NO GUARANTEE OF FUTURE SIZE, COLOR, COAT, OR TEMPERAMENT

The Buyer understands that mature size, exact shade, coat texture, shedding level, retrieving drive, and adult temperament cannot be guaranteed. Puppy energy level, chewing, mouthing, barking, crate adjustment, and house-training accidents are normal puppy behaviors and are not grounds for return, refund, chargeback, or claim against the Breeder.

## 8. BUYER CARE OBLIGATIONS

The Buyer agrees to provide appropriate housing, supervision, socialization, training, parasite prevention, grooming, nutrition, exercise, and timely veterinary care. The Buyer agrees not to allow the Dog to roam freely, be neglected, be abandoned, or be surrendered to a shelter, rescue, broker, store, laboratory, or auction.

The Buyer also agrees that children and guests will be supervised around the puppy and that the home will be kept reasonably free of hazardous swallowable items, toxic substances, and unsafe play situations.

## 9. NO BREEDING / SPAY-NEUTER REQUIREMENT

The Dog is sold on a strict non-breeding basis. The Buyer shall not intentionally or negligently allow the Dog to be bred. Unless the Breeder gives prior written permission otherwise, the Buyer must spay or neuter the Dog at an age recommended by the Buyer's licensed veterinarian and appropriate for the breed, and then provide proof to the Breeder within 14 days of the procedure.

Unauthorized breeding is a material breach of this Agreement. Because unauthorized breeding can damage the Breeder's bloodlines, reputation, and placement program in ways that are difficult to calculate precisely, the Buyer agrees that \$10,000.00 is a reasonable liquidated-damages amount for each unauthorized litter or

breeding event, in addition to any equitable relief allowed by law. The parties intend this amount as a genuine pre-estimate of harm and not as a penalty.

## 10. LIMITED REGISTRATION / PAPERS

Any registration paperwork, if provided, may be limited registration only unless the Breeder later agrees otherwise in a separate signed writing.

## 11. RETURN TO BREEDER / NO RESALE / NO TRANSFER

If at any time the Buyer cannot or will not keep the Dog, the Buyer must notify the Breeder immediately and give the Breeder the first right to retake or assist in rehoming the Dog. The Buyer may not sell, gift, lease, trade, transfer, or surrender the Dog to any third party without the Breeder's prior written consent.

If the Breeder retakes possession of the Dog, the Breeder may, in the Breeder's sole discretion, retain the Dog, place the Dog with another home, or resell the Dog. Unless the parties sign a different written arrangement, the Buyer is not entitled to any refund after the initial return window described below. Any goodwill refund, if offered, is voluntary, may be partial, and may be reduced by the Breeder's costs of recovery, transport, boarding, veterinary care, evaluation, retraining, marketing, and re-placement.

If the Breeder reasonably believes the Dog is at risk of neglect, abuse, unsafe housing, or unauthorized transfer, the Buyer agrees to cooperate in promptly returning the Dog to the Breeder. Title and possession may revert only according to this Agreement and applicable law.

## 12. OPTIONAL EARLY RETURN WINDOW

As a courtesy and not as a continuing obligation, the Breeder may allow an early return for a puppy that is not a suitable match for the Buyer's household if the Breeder is contacted promptly after placement. Any return, replacement, or partial refund during that early period is entirely at the Breeder's discretion unless otherwise required by law.

## 13. NO CHARGEBACKS / NO ONLINE DEFAMATION THREATS

The Buyer agrees to make a good-faith effort to resolve any dispute directly with the Breeder before initiating a payment dispute, chargeback, or public accusation. Nothing in this paragraph limits either party's lawful rights, but the Buyer acknowledges that disagreement over normal puppy behavior, post-transfer accidents, or issues excluded by this Agreement is not a proper basis for a chargeback.

## 14. DEFAULT, ENFORCEMENT, AND ATTORNEY FEES

A breach of Sections 8, 9, 10, or 11 is material. To the extent permitted by law, the prevailing party in an action to enforce this Agreement may recover reasonable attorney fees and costs. The Breeder may seek injunctive or equitable relief where money damages are inadequate.

## 15. GOVERNING LAW / VENUE / ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is governed by Oregon law, without regard to conflict-of-law rules. Any action arising from this Agreement shall be brought in the county and state where the Breeder resides or does business, unless applicable law requires otherwise. This Agreement is the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior oral or written discussions. Any modification must be in a later written document signed by both parties.

If any provision is found unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in effect to the fullest extent allowed by law.

## 16. ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

- The Buyer understands that puppies chew, mouth, jump, cry, have accidents, and require patient training and supervision.
- The Buyer understands that once the puppy leaves the Breeder's care, accidents and illnesses can occur for reasons unrelated to the Breeder.
- The Buyer has had the opportunity to ask questions and understands this Agreement before signing.
- The Buyer understands that this document is a private breeder agreement and is not veterinary advice.

| _____          | <b>Normal puppy behavior</b>   | I understand chewing, mouthing, barking, crate adjustment, accidents, and high energy are normal puppy behaviors and are not proof the puppy was defective or misrepresented.                   |
| _____          | <b>No breeding</b>             | I will not breed this dog and will not allow an accidental breeding. I understand unauthorized breeding is a serious contract violation.  |
| _____          | <b>Spay / neuter</b>           | I will spay or neuter the dog as required by the agreement and provide proof afterward.   |
| _____          | <b>No resale / no shelter</b>  | I will not resell, give away, or surrender this dog to a shelter or rescue without first contacting Redline Goldens.  |
| _____          | <b>Return to breeder first</b> | If I cannot keep the dog for any reason, I will contact Redline Goldens first and follow their rehoming / return instructions.  |
| _____          | <b>Post-transfer costs</b>     | I understand I am responsible for veterinary bills, injury, accident, ingestion, parasite, and supervision-related issues that happen after pickup unless the written agreement says otherwise. |
| _____          | <b>Photos / updates</b>        | I agree to provide reasonable update photos or messages if Redline Goldens checks in after placement, especially if there is any adjustment concern.  |
